






Funding instrument landscape



EUREKA is a programme aimed at strengthening the competitiveness of European industry on the world market and creating collaborations between companies and researchers in the participating countries. The programme finances market-oriented project for the development of new products, services and processes.

- Vinnova is the national contact authority for EUREKA in Sweden, finances and administers funding for Swedish actors.
- Vinnova offers information and the opportunity to apply for funding for Swedish participants in EUREKA project.
- Vinnova allocates around 200 MSEK per year for the EUREKA collaboration.














WHAT DO WE ASSESS?

- The Swedish consortium shall be industrydriven with a good balance between large companies, SMEs and academia / research institutes
- The effort from the participating companies must be at least 60 percent of the Swedish consortium's total work effort. At least one Swedish SME must participate in the project
- Swedish SMEs must have at least 1.0 million SEK in net sales according to the latest annual report and a number of employees that corresponds to at least three full-time equivalents

What should you expect?

- XProject submission is all via the Xecs PROJECT ZONE
 - https://projects.aeneas-office.org/community
- XTwo complementary channels for providing information
 - · Directly in the Xecs PROJECT ZONE
 - Complemented by uploading two files
 - Word document template
 - Excel cost file
- X The SOONER you start, the better!
- X The SOONER you contact your National Funding bodies, the better!





Be aware of Your Audience!

Technical Experts

XTechnical Experts will focus on the impact, quality and viability of the project as a whole

- Extending the State-of-the-Art
- Clear goals and objectives
- Complementary and appropriate consortium
- Stretch, but viable, targets reached through a well organised project
- Relevant to the Xecs programme target (ECS SRIA)





Be aware of Your Audience!

National Funding Authorities

National reviews will focus on National impact within the context of a trans-national collaborative project

- Fulfilling National funding body criteria
- Matching National RD&I focus areas
- Must be addressed individually and collectively by the partners in each country
- Clear impact for the country in return for National support given







Project Outline Annex



General Remarks

- Read the guidance text, and, if you don't understand it, ask the office team
- XKey point: respect the page limits! Going beyond them will be interpreted by the experts as substituting quality by quantity
- XDon't forget a picture is worth a thousand words
- XCheck for correctness of language. Poor English and incorrect spelling make it hard for the evaluators

 - State-of-the-Art (SotA) analysis
 - Summary of technological innovation and novelty in relation to the SotA
 - Expected project outputs
 - · Summary of Project Objectives (measurable)

- · Invite partners
- · Edit partner details
- Add partner associates
- Edit cost & effort for funding (per country)

XFinal project version

- Upload annex document
- Check merged document Submit project version
- · Re-submit version until the given deadline







How to create a consortium?

- XVia the "Partners" tab you can invite a new partner organisation by giving an email address and clicking the button "Invite partner":
 - Invited partners will receive via email your invitation which they will have to accept
- XInviting a partner applies to inviting a partner organisation. An invitation should be sent to and accepted by only 1 person per organisation: the main technical contact for that partner organisation. → Extra contact persons per organisation can be added by via the "Associates" tab (on a partner page).







How to finalise your project version?

Project checklist

General

Annex, PO Cost Detail Annex' are missing in your proposal documents section

AENEAS

- A Partner description is missing
- O AENEAS is missing Role in project, Main Contribution, Strategic importance
- AENEAS is missing Market access
- A Partner has no effort, Indicate effort or deactivate the partner

- XIn the "Management" tab of your project page:
 - Upload the PO annex document
 - Check the merged document
 - Submit the project version
- XIt is highly recommended to already start testing to upload an Annex, checking the merged document and submitting the proposal well in advance before the deadline
- The Project checklist guides you through the missing information you need to provide before being able to submit a version.
- XOnly once all checks are successful, your Project Outline submission button will appear







- Check that there are no blocking points in the project checklist
- Please make use of the re-submit functionality to improve your proposal towards the final version
- XThe deadline IS a deadline
- XThe Xecs office is here to help!
